

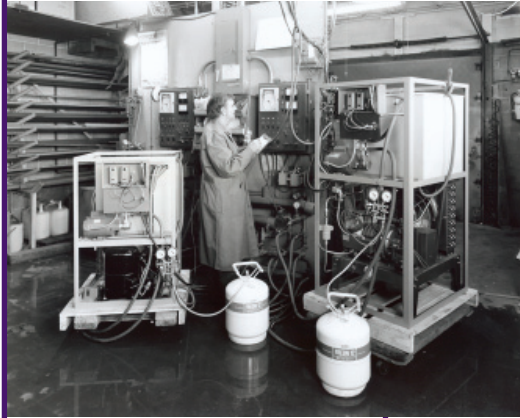
History



1940s The name "Haskris" comes from the founding partners last names. Mr. Haas and Mr. Kristensen formed Haskris as a contracting business in 1944 doing service and installation of refrigeration equipment.

1940s

1950s Haas was approached by a global electronics manufacturer to design a process water chiller to cool the first generation of electron microscope in North America. The first Haskris water chiller is born.



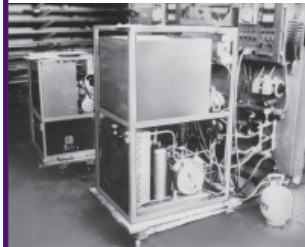

1950s

1960s Haskris becomes the exclusive chiller supplier to every major OEM in the electron microscope industry.

1960s

1970s Dan Falotico Sr. is hired in 1970 to help manage the growth of the company and eventually becomes president/owner. The contracting business is discontinued. Haskris focuses on chillers for high-tech instrumentation and equipment.

1970s

1980s Haskris enters a new industry in analytical x-ray and becomes the exclusive supplier to all major OEMs.

With 10,000+ systems in operation, Haskris reputation for highly engineered products opens the door to new industries including semi-conductor and laser cooling.

1980s

1990s Dan Falotico Jr. joins Haskris and becomes President in 1999. Haskris chillers can now be found in virtually every University, Hospital, Medical Lab, Government Facility and Fortune 500 Company where mission critical, high-technology applications are employed.

1990s

2000s Haskris enters the MRI industry and establishes a new standard for reliability, quality, and support. To date, Haskris has never lost a major OEM customer including its first customer from the 1950s!
